Voice of the Church: Thank you for your feedback

In October, the PSC embarked on a listening journey to learn from you your thoughts about where FBCLG should go in the future. This also was an opportunity to hear from you about what you are looking for in a new pastor. Our prime tools were a survey, several focus groups that were organized by generation, and a town hall meeting. Participation was very strong and your feedback was heard. We intend to use what you've told us to help us guide the pastoral search process and to help set an agenda for the direction of FBCLG over the next several years.

In many ways, this is the most important part of this pastoral selection process. Led by God, you have voiced your desires, concerns, ideas and thoughts regarding the future of this church. We thank you for taking the time to participate.

A search update from Vanderbloemen

In September, Vanderbloemen, our search firm, began an active search process for a new pastor. To date, they have received several hundred resumes. Vanderbloemen is helping the PSC vet potential candidates for pastor. They are conducting the initial review of resumes based upon set criteria, such as whether the candidate has the appropriate qualifications, experience and educational background. The feedback that you provided to us about what you find important in a pastor also is being shared with them.

Vanderbloemen has informed us that the number of submitted resumes is high with many arriving in the last few weeks of October. Some of our church members and clergy also have provided candidate names to them. We thank you for those names. Over the next few weeks it is expected that PSC will see an initial set of resumes for our review. Once this effort begins, we will be actively engaged in reviewing candidate credentials.

Updating FBCLG membership

The PSC, in concert with FBCLG leadership, will begin a process to update our membership database, Faith In Action Central (FIAC). This will allow members to confirm their membership, update vital information, learn how to use FIAC and, for those who have been 'dating' FBCLG, consider joining this house of the Lord. Updating the membership list will help the church in many ways, including keeping you current on

church activities, the ability for ministries to communicate amongst one another, and, ultimately, to ensure that members of the church will have the opportunity to vote to select FBCLG's new pastor next year.
